In this class you will learn about creative problem solving while developing lifelong skills such as responsibility, persistence, observation, and self-reflection. Throughout the year, you will experience a broad variety of artistic opportunities. This course will provide you with a great foundation of skills to help you in higher level art courses such as Drawing & Painting, Sculpture, Photography, and AP Art.

Expectations:

Grading Policy

In this art course A's aren't gifted, they are *earned*. Even students who feel they may not be "artists" can excel in this class based on **effort** and **growth in ability**. Marking period grades will be determined as follows...

Projects: 50%

Completed projects and grading rubrics will be used to determine your success at <u>meeting the</u> <u>criteria of a lesson.</u>

Ample class time will be given to complete projects, if you feel you are falling behind it is *your responsibility* to attend extra help **before** the project is due. Late projects will lose credit.

Art Studies: 30%

You will keep an up to date collection of class notes and art exercises. This will help us keep track of your development over the year.

Homework Assignments: 10%

Homework will be assigned 4 times per marking quarter. Each assignment will be graded and all work must be handed in on time.

PACT Grade: 10%

<u>Positive Art Character Traits: Year 1 is geared toward developing Focus, Respect and</u> Cooperation in the art world.

Your PACT grade will be an assessment of your overall class involvement, behavior, preparedness, effort and attitude. All students are expected to assist in keeping the studio environment in working order by participating in set up and cleanup of materials.

****Please note:** It is expected that you are constantly seeking ways to improve your abilities in the arts. There is *always* room for growth and development, "you don't have to be 'bad', to get better." If you are unhappy with your results the first time, the majority of projects in this class may be redone. If you wish to resubmit your work, please let me know as soon as you receive your grade and we will discuss ways to improve upon it.
